Dear Parents and Caregivers of East Lake School,

I had the joy of attending the ULEAD conference earlier this week in beautiful Banff. Many of the presentations were connected by a thread of leading in an educational community and creating change while also attending to management tasks. I jotted down a line from one of the keynote speakers "be brave enough to start a conversation that matters."

We certainly do a lot of talking at school with our Eagles and dedicated teaching and re-teaching. I was thinking about our Eagle community value of "Accountable" which means to make good choices, do what I say I will do and own my choices. A good choice keeps our mind, body and learning space safe. Doing what I say I will do involves making and honoring a commitment to self and others. 
