 - Brittany and Stephen
- **RVS Trustee Report – Shali Baziuk**
 - Updates on funding/capacity/construction, etc.
 - New high school is #3, Chelsea location (8.95acres), city needs to purchase remaining 7.01 acres required, municipal gov't act requires them legally to purchase site, replied next day and will provide a report at next council meeting, Pat Vincent his planning dept put HS site as highest priority, Shali is attending City Council meeting, Doug and Pat to meet with Shali on Monday, Doug Lagour (Mayor in Council) move funding into reserve to be given to RV for next year,
Capital priority list – modular classroom allocation, requested 22 for all RVS and relocate 12. Received 9 and 1 washroom unit, \$250K to move and do earthworks, asking for reconsideration (1.5M to move 6 modulars from Langdon)
 - French program in Langdon, current grade 8's have largest # of FI class, high on radar for next year, space for program of choice, grade and boundary reconfig discussions will start in fall, no guarantees, requires public consultation, keep advocating and use consultation, parents are complacent and tired
 - Public consultation will happen in fall and will apply for 2025/2026 year

180 projects total, meets students where they are at, independent projects/experiments, every child was proud, top 9 projects go to Calgary Youth Science Fair, 1000 students, 80 schools, if they score over 80 they can get judged in the afternoon, medals are received based on school (gold to honorable mention), consumer science award (mouth wash), soil erosion prevention (GeoScience award, runner up), Hayskane School of business top project for consumer science, Pathways Alliance Award for Innovation and Sustainability (erosion), 1 gold, 5 silver, 3 bronze and honorable mention

What were some of the top projects? Popcorn, Orville (not Costco), Ice melt (ph, pet friendly), how to purify water, golf balls (trajectory), hockey puck (the colder the better)
