Our September 30 th count had our school at just below 900 students in our school but we have since surpassed that number with the continued growth in our community. This will not cause an issue with our school being a P3 at this time as our kindergarten and PIP students are considered 0.5 as they only attend half time.

2. Staffing Updates

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We were able to welcome a new Gr 5 teacher and split out the classes over one more classroom at the end of September. We are starting to see the impact of a country wide teacher shortage as there are less candidates applying for jobs and it has taken longer to find qualified candidates for some specialized areas.
