Dear Parents and Caregivers of East Lake School,

It is almost that time when the formal report card will be available. I also share that moment of anticipation as I read the comments about my children's progress. My children really care about their celebratory meal ideas- one wants Wendy's and one sushi. Both will undoubtedly ask if they can start the next grade on July 1st to which I will gingerly tell them that their new teachers aren't quite ready for them yet.

Teachers collect a lot of data about how students are progressing through the year. "Triangulation of Assessment" means looking at student products, making observations and having conversations with learners. We aim to gather various data points on student learning so that we can plan next steps in instruction.

As parents, there are many ways to gather data on how your student is progressing. As a "Real Time Reporting" school, you can access data in real time online. Many teachers use "MyBlueprint" and social media platforms to share evidence of learning. Teachers are always available to talk about your Eagle's learning in person, via phone or email. Appointments are taken year around. We also have two sets of Student Led Conferences that provide additional times to talk about and celebrate learning.

As a school, we also get to look at bigger picture strengths, challenges and areas to pursue through looking at our data. We can align our professional learning for staff and create structures and supports that meet the needs of our learners (both students and adult professionals). Data we consider includes RVS assessment pieces, survey responses, PAT's, PowerSchool data, teacher observations, report cards, student attendance etc. Rocky View Schools also does this on a much larger scale looking at data from all 52 schools.

Learning is cyclical and is ongoing which means our data collection is as well. It's a snapshot of a learner, at one particular time with a particular task. We are here to support all learners, all of the time, in whatever way they need. We are also here to celebrate the wins- big and small.

### Register Now for 2024/25 Bus Transportation

Time is running out to receive a discount on your transportation registration! Families who register before June 30 will receive an early registration discount of \$40. This is extended to each of the first two students in a family, with additional students receiving \$20 off if registering early. A minimum payment of 50 per cent is due at registration. Bus service may be cancelled up until Oct. 31, 2024 to receive a full refund. A step-by-step guide to registration is available on <a href="Transportation Registration">Transportation</a> Registration & Fee Payment.

To guarantee service for the first day of school, registration must be received before Aug. 1. Students registered after this deadline may experience delays of two to three weeks before they can ride the bus as late applications will be processed with a start date after Sept. 18.

Transportation fees for 2024/25 will remain the same as 2023/24.
