"Starting in a good way" is a goal of ours at East Lake School and a hope that we have for each Eagle entering the school each morning. Our school is hovering just below 1000 students and we have 70 staff who also need to get to school safely. We have 18 school buses that serve East Lake. We have many students who are dropped off. We have had visits from RVS transportation, Chestermere RCMP and Peace Officers who are also looking to team with our school community to ensure safety is a priority. We appreciate their thoughts, suggestions and presence at East Lake.

Doors open at 7:50am for our Eagles. Our staff commitment is to meet kids and welcome them into a day of learning. We have a "homeroom" time until 8:15am where teachers have an opportunity to connect with kids and "start in a good way."
