Dear Parents and Advocates of East Lake School,

It's hard to believe the end of October is here! Next week will exciting here at East Lake.

On Tuesday we welcome Rocky View Schools Learning Specialists Carolane Contant, Landry Forand and Joshua LaFleur for an RVS Learning Cycle. Carolane brings a rich French Immersion background, Landry a Mathematics skill set and Joshua a passion for English as Additional Language learners and Universal Design for Learning. They will be here for a five week residency where they will be supporting our teachers in house with Building Thinking Classrooms. We can look at many school based initiatives through a Building Thinking Classrooms lens- literacy, numeracy, supporting English as an Additional Language learners and Foundational Ways of Knowing. Their elbow to elbow coaching can and will include task design and implementation, assessment and room design. The Cycle will support our year long study of Peter Liljedahl's work which focusses on tasks, collaborative groups, classroom arrangement, lesson consolidation and assessment. Staff work with the specialists will support their teacher professional growth plans, our East Lake School Education Plan and Rocky View's Four Year Plan.
