Dear Parents and Supporters of East Lake School,

Do you ever ask your Eagle "how did it go today?" to be met with a limited response? You then might wonder, how it is <u>really</u> going? Luckily, we have many avenues to get you the information that you need!

The first stop for academic and social-emotional wellness is your classroom teacher. Always feel free to reach out with any questions and concerns. Teachers are great resources to share observations, discuss products of learning and provide guidance for extending learning outside of school. You can reach your Eagle's teacher over the phone, via email, in person or over Zoom by appointment at any point throughout the year.

Student data is at your fingertips in Powerschool, Google classroom and through Myblueprint. As we are an RTR (Real Time Reporting) school, one formal report card is created in June. Please reach out to your Eagle's teacher if you have questions about these platforms. All of these digital tools provide additional context and feedback for learning. You can access our social media feed on Instagram or Facebook to see some big picture highlights of learning and growing at East Lake.

Student Led Conferences (grades 1-6) are coming up November 6 and 7th. These are opportunities for students to showcase their learning to an adult, reflect and set goals for upcoming learning. Appointment times will be available starting October 28th. We will follow a "triangulation of assessment" model which includes observation, products of learning and discussion with the teacher. These evenings are not set up for significant problem solving so please reach out to the teacher if anything is heavy on your mind ahead of time. Kindergarten families will have an opportunity in early December to connect with classroom teachers to talk about their Eagle's learning.

We also have a great team to support students through Learning Support. Mr. MacDonald and Mrs. Beriault are key point people if your Eagle has a Student Support Plan or other specified learning needs. Mrs. Siddall and Mrs. Lamba are wonderful leaders and advocates for English as an Additional Language Learners and their families. Mrs. Lloyd is a Learning Coach and has a wealth of wisdom to support teachers and learners. Ms. Edeburn and Ms. Corry are our Child Development Advisors if your Eagle would like social-emotional supports at school.

We are all here to work together in team to support each Eagle in having a great day at school. You are the expert on your Eagle- if there is every anything you believe would help us to support them more successfully, please feel free to it pass along.
