# 2. Shalli:

- Superintendent has announced his retirement effective end of August 2025. Recruitment company engaged for executive search
- Student accommodation consult on Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> at middle-school (6:30PM)
- RVS engage (online survey), already open on website to see available options (open until Dec 12<sup>th</sup>).
- Option for everyone to attend, in person or zoom, on Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> to voice your opinion. The slides being presented on the 22<sup>nd</sup> are available online
- Delegations to the board on Dec 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Anyone can attend and ask for 10 minutes to present their thoughts/opinions to 8 person board (this includes Shalli)
  - There are six different options. Information for all six are available online. Only the most viable option will be presented:

- East Lake English goes from K-6 to K-9. Christian and French K-6 stay here, 7-9 stays at middle-school
- Decision made on Jan 23rd
- Joint board student council meeting on Oct 24<sup>th</sup>. School council executive (Janelle) will attend. This is also open to others as, let Shalli know if you would like to attend

# 3. Janelle (Chair report):

- Encourage everyone to attend Oct 22<sup>nd</sup>, link for zoom will be sent
- Janelle will be at joint meeting on Oct 24<sup>th</sup> and will present findings at next council meeting in November
- There has been a request to have <u>Canadian Parents for French Alberta</u> come speak with students, to discuss advocating for French immersion. This is an opportunity to understand what the province is doing to support French immersion
- A representative (Micheal) will attend meeting in November or January to come and speak on this

# 4. Amanda:

- As of today school population is 1010, however this changes daily
- Additional teacher time in December; ½ kindergarten teacher and a full-time teacher with a 2/3 split. All class sizes in acceptable range, although on the larger size
- Have submitted school education plan, it will be reviewed and discussed at the next meeting (called ABC)
- On-going discussions taking place about <u>PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and</u> <u>Support)</u> to determine if its working well. Eastlake is an early adapter of this.
- Health and wellness focus
  - Several staff leadership groups such as school educational plan champion, Indigenouse learning, PBIS group
  - Soccer and Track have just wrapped up
  - Volleyball is starting up
- Student lead conferences for Grades 1 to 6 are on Nov 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. Parents invited to start booking appointments
  - Each teacher will have 3 families at a time in the classroom for 15 minute increments
- Kindergarten will not have student lead conferences this time around. At the beginning of Dec, K-team will meet with parents in a trandationanl 1:1 dialogue
- Parents are always encouraged to reach out to teachers/school (via email, phone, online ect) throughout the year for student updates. They do not have to wait until parentteacher conference
- Diwali and Halloween coming up (same week). Diversity committee has suggested to celebrate Diwali on Oct 30<sup>th</sup>. Kids encouraged to dress in their traditional clothing.
  - Dance party in the afternoon on this day
- Oct 31<sup>st</sup> will be Halloween celebration

# 5. Crosswalk:

- There was an accident, not involving children
- o Double-cross walk is an on-going issue
- Lots of studies done but nothing has been done about this
- One suggestion is bump outs or speed bumps. Speed bumps are being considered
- Best way to voice concern is to email a council member or mayor so they can forward to the right person
