Dear Adults of our Eagles,

Now that winter seems to have arrived, it's important to revisit the "S" in S.O.A.R. which stands for safety. Eagles are to arrive no earlier than 7:50am in the morning when the doors open and supervision is present. If arriving by car or foot, please be safe on Kinniburgh Blvd by remaining on sidewalks and crosswalks and following the speed limit. A reminder that our staff parking lot and bus loop are closed during drop off and pick up times.

All Eagles need to be properly dressed for winter with an expectation to be outside for recess and lunch breaks. The fresh air is an important part of the day and students enjoy it when dressed for the weather (boots, mitts, snow pants, toques and jackets). To keep our floors dry and clean, Eagles must switch to indoor shoes when arriving at school. If you feel your Eagle is missing a mitt, jacket or other clothing, please have them check out our lost and found on the main floor.

Our school has systems in place to ensure safety through our "Hour Zero" protocols, training and OH&S requirements such as onsite first aid trained staff. We ask that all emergency contacts are kept up to date please in the event we need to get a hold of you due to sickness or injury. We are pleased to have excellent working relationships with RVS OH&S and the Public Health Nurse assigned to our school- Leah Boulton-Chaykowksi.

Our campus is closed during school hours. This means all visitors (parents included) must report to the main office to sign in and only use the front doors. The playground and school property are closed to the public during the day.

Please know that if there was ever an event with emergency services on site, we will report back to students and parents. We have a protocol around communication within RVS and with families that keeps everyone safe and informed.


## Winter is coming...
