**Grade 7-9 Students are required to bring their own school supplies.**

Each teacher may hand out an additional supplementary supply list in September for other specific supplies they require.

Students will need to replace lost or used supplies throughout the year.

**Grade 6 - 9 students are encouraged to have their own laptop.** This can be a Windows device, a Mac laptop or a Chromebook. Smartphones are **not** allowed. (Basic requirement: - can connect to WIFI - good battery life - audio and video capability (speaker, microphone and camera) - working keyboard and trackpad/mouse).
