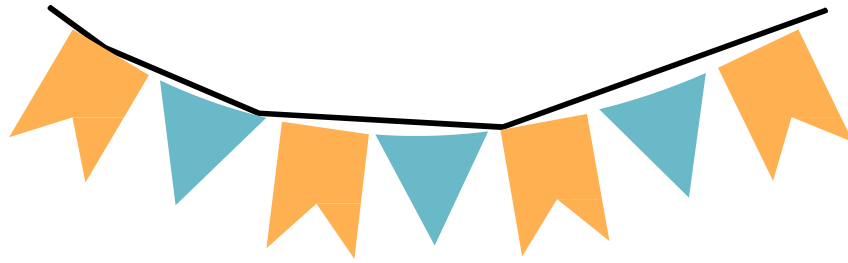
The next meeting for our parent council is coming up and our Learning Support Team will be sharing information on our inclusive education strategy that is being seen as model amongst schools in Rocky View
